A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PREPARATION OF A TRIBAL TRANSIT PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION BY THE CITY AND ONC AND ITS SUBMISSION BY ONC

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration announced in the July 25, 2011 Federal Register the availability of grant funds as part of the Public Transportation on Indian Reservations Program, known as the Tribal Transit Program;

WHEREAS, the Bethel Transit System is funded in large part by City and ONC grants and to a lesser extent by farebox revenues;

WHEREAS, as the tribe in Bethel, ONC is an eligible organization to apply for, receive, and administer tribal transit grant funds;

WHEREAS, ONC received two tribal transit grants that helped fund the operation of the Bethel Transit System: one in 2005 valued at \$105,193, and one in 2006 valued at \$136,370;


WHEREAS, Grant proposals are due September 26, 2011;


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and Orutsararmiut Native Council routinely collaborate on grants to support the operation of the Bethel Transit System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council agrees to cooperate with ONC in the preparation and submission of an FY 2011 Tribal Transit Grant application.
