### **Resolution # 11-25**

#### **ACCEPT AND APPROVE ALASKA STATE DESIGNATED LEGISLATIVE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$350,000 TO FUND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF LED STREET LIGHTS IN BETHEL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel has been appropriated a FY 2012 Designated Legislative Grant in the amount of \$350,000 to purchase and install LED street lights;

**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce Community and Economic Development, is currently preparing a grant agreement for the City to sign;

**WHEREAS**, the grant requires no cash or in-kind match from the City of Bethel;


**WHEREAS**, the City replaced 81 of its high pressure sodium street lights with LED street lights thus far in order to save upwards of 30% on the cost electricity;


**WHEREAS**, funding from this grant is expected to allow 100% of Bethel's high pressure sodium street lights to be replaced with LED street lights;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council accepts and approves the State of Alaska's FY 2012 Designated legislative grant to the City in the amount of \$350,000 for the purchase and installation of LED street lights.
