ACCEPT AND APPROVE ALASKA STATE DESIGNATED LEGISLATIVE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$328,000 TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF GOODS AND SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH RELOCATING THE POLICE DISPATCH SYSTEM FROM ITS CURRENT LOCATION TO THE NEW POLICE STATION SITE

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has been appropriated a FY 2012 Designated Legislative Grant in the amount of \$328,000 to cover the costs associated with relocating the police dispatch system from its current location to the new police station site on Salmonberry;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce Community and Economic Development, is currently preparing a grant agreement for the City to sign;

WHEREAS, the grant requires no cash or in-kind match from the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, the project includes the purchase and installation of an 80 ft. communications tower on the new police station site;


WHEREAS, this project dovetails perfectly with the City's outstanding grant request to the Alaska Division of Homeland Security for new 911 dispatch hardware and software;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council accepts and approves the State of Alaska's FY 2012 Designated legislative grant to the City in the amount of \$328,000 to pay for costs associated with relocating and establishing the police dispatch system at the new police station site.
