ACCEPT AND APPROVE ALASKA STATE DESIGNATED LEGISLATIVE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$246,000 TO FUND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF ONE EMERGENCY POWER GENERATOR

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has been appropriated a FY 2012 Designated Legislative Grant in the amount of \$246,000 to fund the purchase and installation of one emergency power generator at the new police station site;


WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Commerce Community and Economic Development, is currently preparing a grant agreement for the City to sign;

WHEREAS, the grant requires no cash or in-kind match from the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, the City's new police station on Salmonberry Street will require a back-up power source in order to ensure the availability of electricity to the police station, including its 911 dispatch system, holding cells, security system, and parking lot lights;


