ACCEPT AND APPROVE FISCAL YEAR 2011 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG)

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, solicited grant applications for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY 2011 Local Solicitation;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel applied for and was awarded a JAG grant in the amount of \$11,001 for the purchase of one or more of the following: personal body cameras, in-car video cameras, or digital audio recorders;


WHEREAS, this grant requires no cash or in-kind match from the City;
