A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE APPOINTMENT OF ALASKA BOARD OF GAME MEMBERS FROM THE YUKON KUSKOKWIM REGION

WHEREAS, the Alaska Board of Game is comprised of seven members from around the state that are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Legislature for three year terms;

WHEREAS, the Board is tasked with passing regulations to conserve and develop Alaska's wildlife resources;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Alaska Statutes, members are appointed on the basis of interest in public affairs, good judgment, knowledge, and ability in the field of action of the board and with a view to providing diversity of interest and points of view of the membership;


WHEREAS, to help satisfy the requirements of providing diversity on the Board, it is in the best interest of the state to have a voice from the Yukon Kuskokwim Region which is one of the largest regions in the state with an approximate population of 25,000 residents, consisting of primarily subsistence harvesters;

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council urges the Governor to consider appointing a resident from the Yukon Kuskokwim Region to the Alaska Board of Game, to provide consistency in the makeup of the Board and to further strengthen the overall decisions the Board makes on protecting and preserving the state's natural habitats and game populations;


