A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE BETHEL FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THEIR EFFORTS TO WORK WITH THE YUKON-KUSKOKWIM HEALTH CORPORATION IN SEEKING GRANT MONIES FOR PHASE IV OF THE CODE BLUE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Bethel Fire Department, in conjunction with the Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation, has identified available grant monies from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA); and

WHEREAS, this portion of the funding requires the Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation (YKHC), as the regional Emergency Medical Office, to apply for funding on the City's behalf; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of funding requested by the City of Bethel through Phase IV of the Code Blue Project is \$2,248, which would be used to upgrade emergency medical equipment; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated local match required by the City of Bethel is \$1,665.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council supports the grant-seeking efforts of the Bethel Fire Department and directs Administration to prepare a budget modification with the General Fund fund balance as the source of the required City of Bethel local cash match.
