A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL CONDITIONALLY PROTESTING THE ISSUANCE OF A RETAIL MARIJUANA LICENSE TO ALASKAN GROWN CANNABIS LICENSE NO. 20440, ALASKAN GROWN PRODUCTS, LLC PROPOSING TO OPERATE AT 1510 CHIEF EDDIE HOFFMAN HIGHWAY, BETHEL

WHEREAS, Alaskan Grown Products, LLC submitted an application for a Retail Marijuana Facility to the State of Alaska Alcohol Marijuana Control Office (AMCO), License #20440, notice of the application was received by the City Clerk's Office on August 26, 2019, deadline for Council's Protest on the Application is October 25, 2019;

WHEREAS, the proposed location of the retail marijuana license is a connex located at 1510 Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway;

WHEREAS, on September 10, City Administration submitted a report to the City Council;

WHEREAS, this administrative report identified that as of September 10, the applicant had not yet applied for a conditional use permit with the City's Planning Department;


WHEREAS, Bethel Municipal Code Chapter 5.10.070 requires each operator of a marijuana establishment obtain a conditional use permit;

WHEREAS, Alaskan Grown Cannabis is not in compliance with our zoning regulation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Bethel City Council conditionally protests the issuance of the marijuana retail license to Alaska Grown Cannabis License No. 20440 because they are not in compliance with the City's zoning requirements.
