Landfill Vehicle Disposal and Property Release



Vehicle disposal is available Monday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. If payment is required for the disposal of the vehicle, payment must be made with the Utility Department in advance. This form with the proof of payment shall be presented to the landfill attendant. Additionally a landfill attendant must sign off on the vehicle, vehicles cannot be unattended on landfill property. You will be required to provide a valid form of identification when submitting this form for billing and verification purposes.

Description	Criteria	Status
Crankcase Oil	Oil Plug removed and all oil drained.	
Brake Fluid	Master cylinder reservoir emptied.	
Batteries	All batteries removed.	
Transmission Fluid	Transmission, transaxles, transfer cases drained.	
Gas/Fuel Tanks	Emptied.	
Radiators	Lower radiator hose disconnected and radiator empty.	
Windshield Fluids	Drained.	
Hazardous Materials	Any containers that may contain hazardous materials removed.	
CFC (Air Conditioner)	Prior removal of the air conditioner is requested.	
Trash	Trash, refuse and other material should be removed.	

- Free : first two vehicle disposals that have all fluids and batteries removed.
- \$200: third and subsequent vehicle disposal with fluids removed.
- \$300: vehicles without fluids drained and batteries removed.
